

Internet Research Project

Conduct an Internet search to find, document, and organize information on a specific topic. Focus on narrowing down your search, with the various search techniques (try various search engines, use unique words, search by phrases, enclose search terms in quotation marks, etc.) to make the information you find more manageable.

- The topic of your research is **Internet Safety**.
Focus Correction Areas: Answer the question, *What is Internet Safety and why is it important?*
Information is organized and meaningful – includes tips for staying safe on-line.
Appropriate source information is provided.
- The only resource you need to use is the Internet.
- You will work independently on this assignment.
- Type a report of your findings and be prepared to talk about your report during a class discussion on the topic.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Conduct an effective Internet search of the topic – *Internet Safety*.
2. Find and document at least **three sources** of information as you search. Properly documented Internet sources include the following information:
 - Author's name
 - Title of the Web page
 - Title of the information
 - Web site address (URL)
 - Date the site was last updated
 - Date you found the information



HINT: The most reliable sources will list many or all of these items.

3. If necessary, print the information that you plan to use in your report; however, **don't print unnecessary information**.
4. Organize and type your report in a neat, orderly fashion.
5. Your report should be one or two pages; turn in one report for your team and be sure to type all names on the paper.
6. On a separate page, include a list of your source information.
7. Prepare to share your findings with the class.
